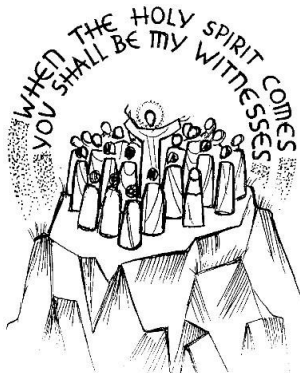

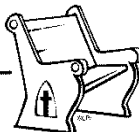
Adoration Moment
