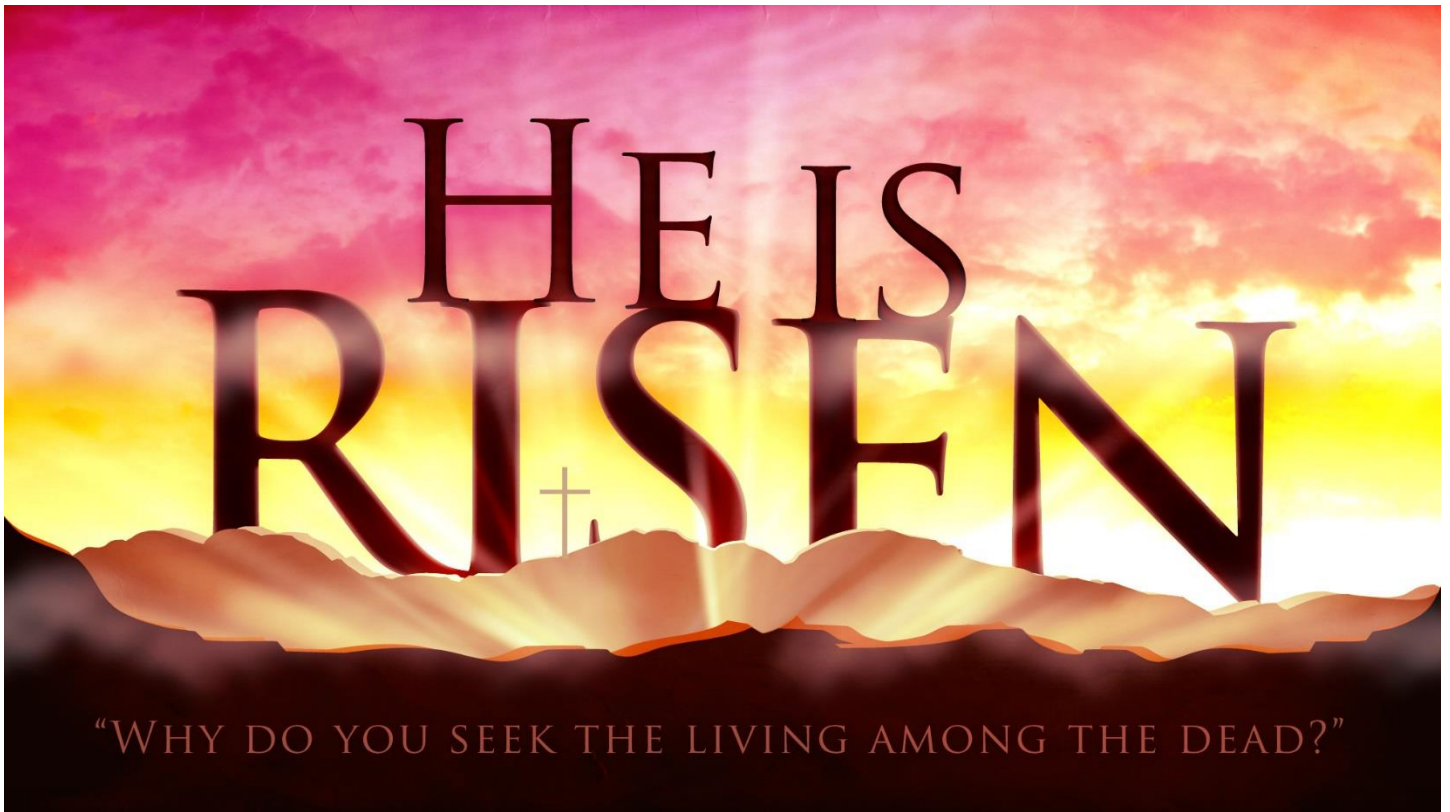
Knights of Columbus Scholarship
