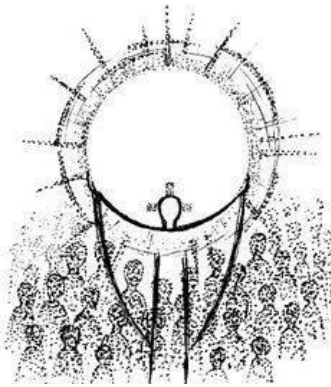

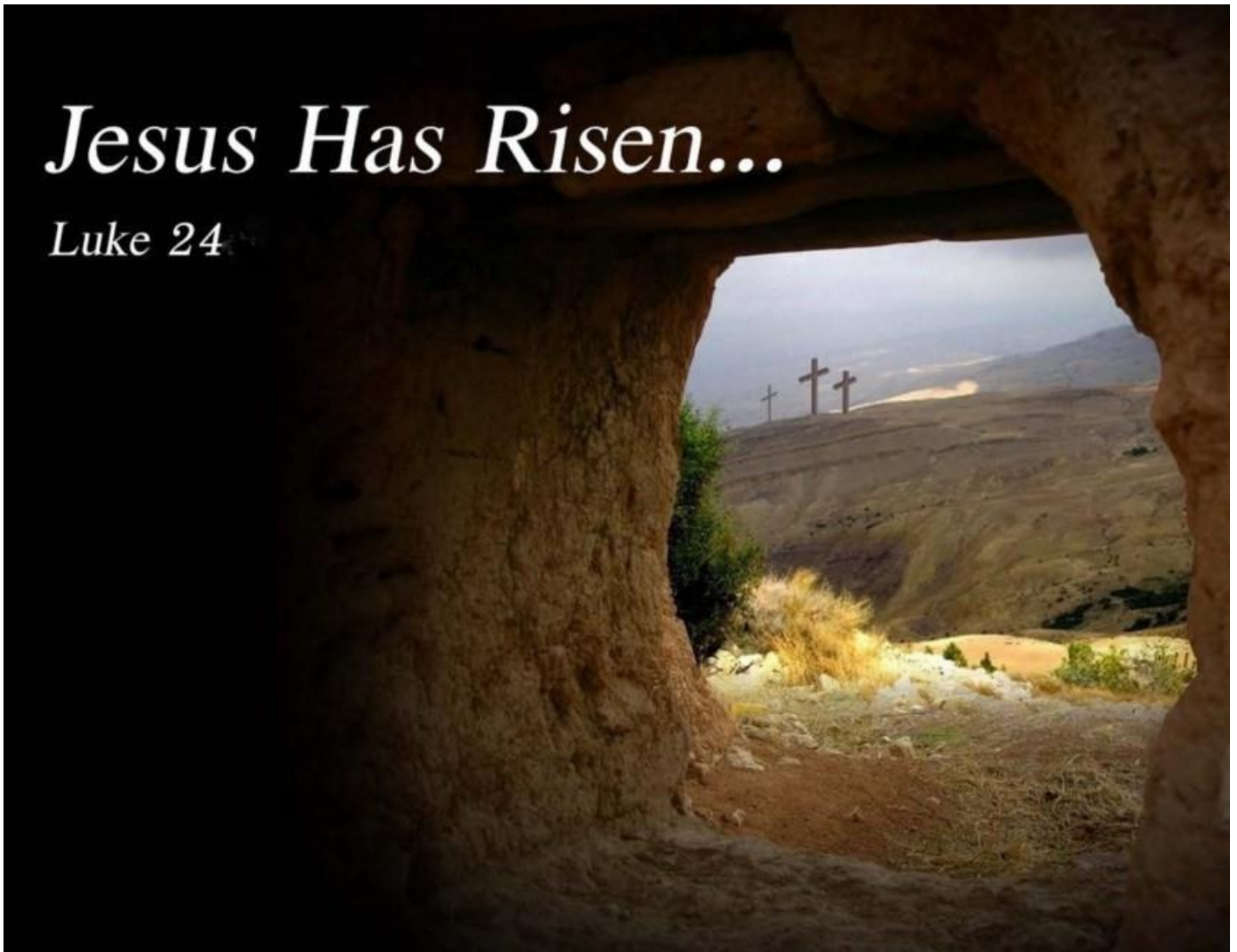
Knights of Columbus Scholarship
