Saints Anne and Joachim
Parents of the Virgin Mary
Grandparents of Jesus



This coming Thursday, July 26th, is the feast day of St. Joachim and St. Anne, the parents of Mary, which makes them the grandparents of Jesus.

How wonderful that Jesus has grandparents! St. Joachim and St. Anne remind us of the mystery of the Incarnation: God truly became man and entered into a human family that included not only his mother Mary and father Joseph but their parents, and their parents, and their parents, all the way back to Adam and Eve at the dawn of creation. Like all of us, Jesus was born into a web of relationships, the "cradle of life and love" that is the family (John Paul II, *Christifideles Laici*, no. 40).

We know little about Sts. Anne and Joachim but we can trust that it was in the home of Joachim and Ann where the Virgin Mary received her training to be the Mother of God. Tradition depicts Anne and Joachim as loving and dedicated parents to their daughter, Mary. Artwork often shows Mary on her mother's lap, learning how to read. It is no stretch to imagine that St. Joachim and St. Anne laid the groundwork for Mary's faith, preparing her to answer one day to the angel Gabriel "Behold, the handmaid of the Lord. Be it done to me according to thy word."

This week as we celebrate Sts. Anne and Joachim, who are the patron saints of grandparents, we thank God for the family Jesus was born into and we rejoice in the gift of family given to each of us.
