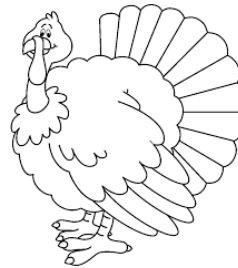
Community Thanksgiving Dinner
